Political	How is the disease viewed in the political spectrum? Locally, globally?	
Economic	Cost of treatment? Cost of disease burden? How can disease (infection rates, length of infection, complications, etc) impact the economy? Think in various nations. Think of the major age of infection and how that will have downstream consequences.	
Social	Public health concerns? How has the disease influenced cultural norms throughout history where it has been endemic? Where is it currently endemic? How has it changed the population?	

Technology (media)	<p>How is the disease portrayed through history (books, myths, stories, as well as educational materials from the government or research/cure groups, etc)?</p> <p>In current literature?</p> <p>In movies/online?</p> <p>On social media - is there an increase in awareness or movement about it?</p>

Environmental	<p>How will global climate change impact the disease burden?</p> <p>How do preventative measures affect the environment?</p>
